HOW TO ENTER

The competition takes place across three categories - two individual and one team. All entrants need to read the rules overleaf and complete an online entry form at nihf.co.uk by Friday 29th March.

Individual entrants are required to attend an assessment day on the morning of Tuesday 16th April in the Clayton Hotel Belfast. This day assesses skills in teambuilding, leadership, initiative and more. Candidates who progress from the morning assessment will be interviewed in the afternoon. A list of finalists will be invited to further interviews, which take place on Tuesday 23rd April. The team competition judging is kept secret but following a series of mystery shops, a list of finalists is reached and a mystery shopper visits each premises to further assess the reception team. A full report is sent to all entrants after the competiton.

There is no cost to enter either competiton or for any judging but hotels are asked to reimburse the accommodation and food costs for the Mystery Shopping.
